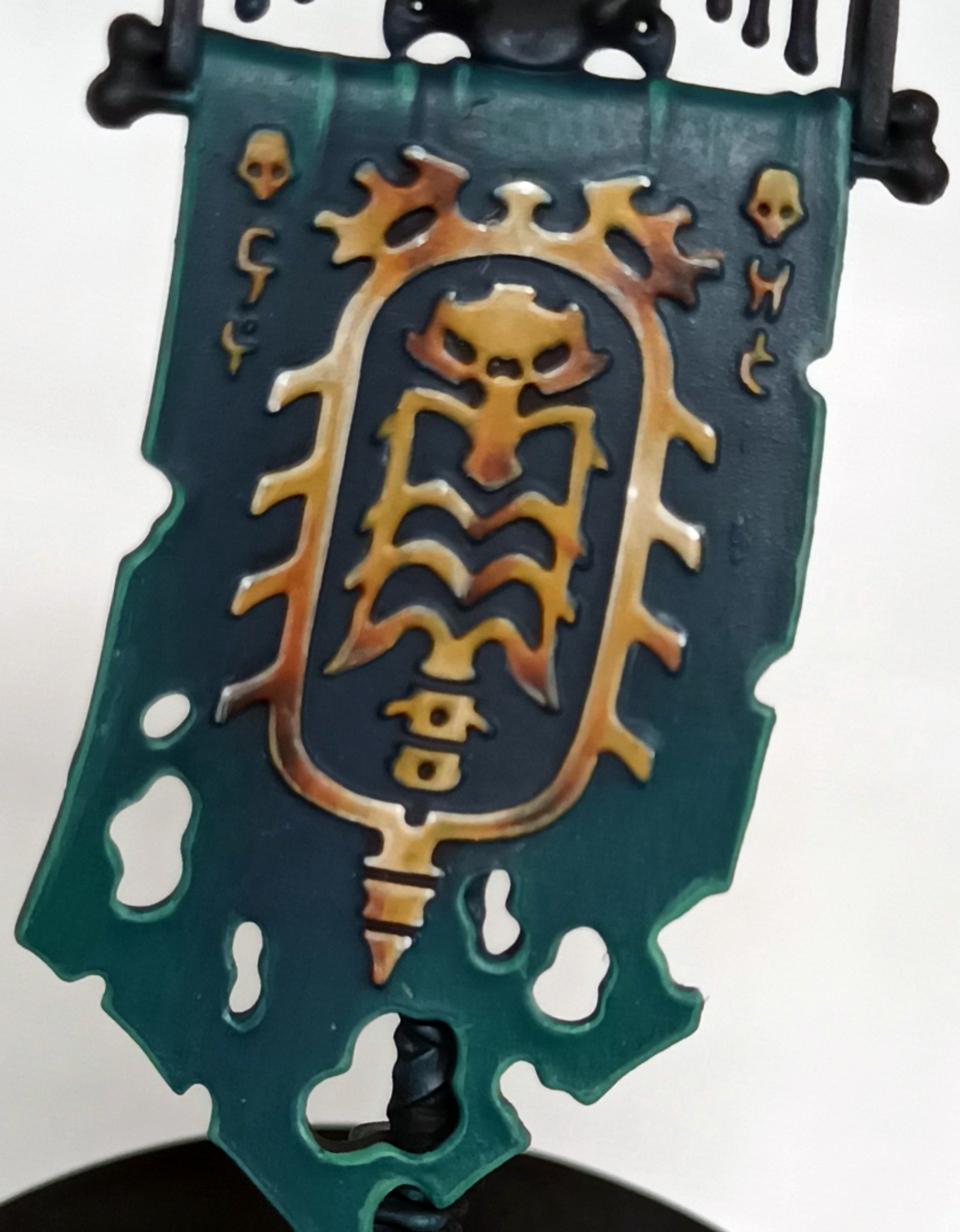

# INTRODUCTION

Hello, Darren here. In this tutorial I will be painting the Ossiarch Bonereapers Stalliarch Lords.

Hello Darren here, and in this tutorial I will be looking at how to paint the banners for Ossiarch Bonereapers.

This tutorial is part of our series of tutorials for the legions of the Bonereapers. Here I'll be covering how to paint the banner insignia in a non-metallic metal style to match the box art. Refer to the tutorial for your legion for other colours.

In this tutorial I will be using the colours of the Null Myriad, whereas you'll want to match the main cloth colours, spot colours and details to your own chosen legion.

I only used a small selection of my typical brush sizes for this - I prefer Kolinsky sable.

# BONEREAPER BANNERS



## STEP 1

Basecoat the insignia using **Balor Brown**.



## STEP 2

Glaze in **Doombull Brown** to start to create the dark shadows. This will take a couple of layers and it's important to ensure each layer is dry before adding the next layer.



## STEP 3

Darken the shadows further by glazing in **Rhinox Hide**. This will also take couple of layers so again, ensure each layer is dry before adding the next.

## STEP 4

Using **Ushabti Bone** block in a highlight toward the centre of the Balor Brown sections, followed by an edge highlight around all edges of the insignia.



## STEP 5

Using **Screaming Skull** highlight the previous layer further, along with an edge highlight concentrating on just the sharpest points of the insignia.



## STEP 6

Using **Wraithbone**, apply a further edge highlight around the periphery of the insignia.

## STEP 7

Apply a final extreme highlight to the sharpest corners of the insignia using **White Scar**.







Using the same method and colour placement will allow you paint any banner in the Bonereapers range.

This is a method that will get better with practice and once you become comfortable with the process it becomes very easy to replicate.
