







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Ganondorf's female form, Melika, is a drastic change from his once tall intimidating form. The escape from Zelda's Dungeon has left her in an extremely weakened state.

Hello everyone, LurkerGG here. Over the last couple of years I have been working on "Lending Link Out," a Legend of Zelda Adult Parody comic. It's been a wild ride, but I have a big announcement to make. I will be rebooting "Lending Link Out" into "Lending Loup Out." I will do my best to provide my reasoning in the F.A.Q below, but this was not a decision I made lightly or alone. I made sure to seek out feedback from supporters and others who have worked on the project before coming to this decision.

So let's get to the nitygritty;

Why reboot LLO?

It was Changing - I had changed the characters and the world of the source material so much that it had become its own thing. Characters didn't act or look the same as they did in the games, so it seemed simple to push a little more with name changes and design changes in order to create a work that was more my own than a full parody.

Creative freedom - While I had changed a lot already, I was restricted in certain other story aspects. How the world worked, the number of characters who had overlapping themes, and just the sheer number of characters that people wanted to see were all difficult to work around. Now I have more freedom to change things to better fit what I want to create.

DMCA - Let's be honest, papa Nintendo is not the friendliest to fan projects. Changing LLO into its own legally distinct project avoids their ire, and just leads to everyone being a lot happier overall.

What's Going to Change in LLO?

Names and Faces - All of the characters names and designs will be changed to match the rebooted look of the project. You may notice characters also act differently than the character they were a parody of, but know that this was already a change I had made during the initial version of LLO. Midna, Impa, and Saria aren't actually that cock-hungry.

Moving from Comic to Visual novel format - I will be moving the project to more of a visual novel format. While I still plan to make shorter comics when time permits, I want to expand into more interactive story telling media.

Refined Story - When I started the initial LLO, the story was written while making the comic, with no plan whatsoever. That has changed, and the story going forward will be far more structured, with a planned beginning and ending.
