Hendrix Style Repetition Lick – Lick of the Week 9-13-16

Hello friends and welcome to another Swiftlessons Lick of the Week! In this tutorial I'll break down one of my favorite Hendrix style repetition licks that you can use to fill in space, and build the tension within your solos. Tabs for additional licks are included below our lick of the week, and are broken down in the extended cut of this lesson for premium patrons. Once you have each lick mastered in the key of E, I recommend practicing over backing tracks in a variety of keys. Let's get started!

Source Scales:

1) E Minor Blues: **E, G, A, B, D, E** (Red = Root Notes)
