



Death jester
turquoise cloak
Step-by-step

◆ **Paints required:**

◆ **Turquoise cloak**

- **Turquoise (Vallejo mc)**
- **Black green (Vallejo mc)**
- **Abaddon black (Vallejo mc)**
- **Light turquoise (Vallejo mc)**





Before we start painting the miniature, we locate the light reflections on the cloak, by taking a picture of it under our desk lamp. I primed it in Chaos Black as it has a great shine to it. I have added a guide for how to locate light reflections in the post description.



We start by basecoating the cloak with a 1:1:1 mix of turquoise, black green & abaddon black.



We now glaze the frame of the light reflections, by adding a 1/2 part of turquoise & black green to the basecoat mix – add 2-3 parts of water.



We now add a $\frac{1}{2}$ part of light turquoise to the previous mix & glaze towards the center of the light reflections.



We now add another $\frac{1}{2}$ part of light turquoise to the previous mix & glaze the center of the light reflections.



We now shade the remaining areas, by adding 1 part more of abaddon black to the basecoat mix – add 2-3 parts of water. We furthermore add small scratches by painting thin lines & dots with a 1:1 mix of turquoise & light turquoise. We furthermore edge highlight with the same mix. If we want more power in the very center of the light reflections, we can finish off by glazing with pure light turquoise. Finished 😊 !
