The 10 Most Powerful Spellcasters in Omeria



he spellcasters on this list are the 10 most powerful spellcasters known to Pexian scholars who are still operating—living or unliving—in the continent of Omeria in 1045 of the Age of Triumphs. Excluded from the list are aberrants, divine creatures, and other unusual forces of arcane might.

THE PEXIA SCALE

The Pexia scale (or P-scale), or Pexian-Arco scale (PA scale), is a scale for rating spellcaster power, based primarily on the damage spellcasters can inflict on humanoid-built structures and vegetation using a single invocation.

The official Pexia scale category is determined by Pexiaapproved arcane scholars and engineers after a ground or aerial damage survey or both; and depending on the circumstances, range of destruction, reality-warping effects, witness testimonies, scholar findings, and damage imagery, as well as illusiogrammetry.

NINETY-THREE

Recently added to the list, the child calling itself Ninety-three is the most dangerous operating spellcaster known to date. The child created a portal into the Void, destroying 25-squaremiles of farmland north of Greatwell in Presson's Enclave, killing an estimated 1,300 humanoids.

Broov

The dragon Broov created the arco-hurricane Clashmount, obliterating an entire Cabalese military and flooding the Weysevain Coast in the process. The hurricane resulted in 695 directly related deaths and tens of millions in gold worth of property damage.

THE BLUE MAGE

When the Blue Mage first appeared, he released a wave of psychic torrent that obliterated the town of Jaetalos near Olyothyr. The wave was felt across all of Omeria, resulting in hundreds of psion deaths. Krigs were particularly susceptible.

NINETY-ONE

The mage named Ninety-one destroyed close to 2,000 acres of Wallingmiotta forest during his solo battle with Queen Meyór and the Dead of Ayas Kelren in 1043 AT.

Minteco

The danaavrakt Minteco teleported the town of Jariyah to the Cruel, instantly killing thousands of humanoid men in the process. Although the Jariyan women and their infants were recovered, the town itself remains in the Cruel.

Moreen Trask

During the War of the Burning Plains, Trask single-handed slew Rymraid, Eater Of All and a full legion of dragonblood warriors with a single spell. Note: some Pexian scholars believe Trask should be placed higher on the list due to the high level of difficulty involved in ancient-wyrm slaying.

VADRIKEN

The warlock Vadriken combined the power of his three patrons to turn the entire town of Truling upside down. Over 500 humanoids died in the event and thousands more were injured. Vadriken's placement on this list is hotly contested as Pexian scholars consider warlocks "borrowers" and not true spellcasters.

JAVON SIED

Javon Sied tapped into the might of the Four Generals to collapse Tiswater Summit in an earthquake felt across most of Northern Omeria as well as parts of Central Omeria. An estimated 450 wyrmlings, kobolds, and other drake kin were killed in the event. Javon Sied's placement on this list is hotly contested as Pexian scholars consider clerics "borrowers" and not true spellcasters.

FAZEL RASTKAR

The lich Fazel Rastkar pulled the souls from 425 Naqqadi Legionnaires during the War of Dyhl in 1034 AT.

SHI XENEM

Shi Xenem used an *Orb of Death* spell to destroy seven Dinzer warblimps during a Dinzer raid on Suong Shindian. 405 Dinzer pilots, crewmen, and soldiers were slain.
