




How to Use the Open Position Pentatonic Scale Lick of the Week 9-20-16

Hello friends and welcome to another Swiftlessons Lick of the Week! In this tutorial I'll break down one of my go-to licks within the open position of the E minor pentatonic scale. Use the attached "Anatomy of the Open Em Pentatonic Scale" (full size image on PG.2) diagram to memorize the numeric intervals associated with each note in the scale. Once we've familiarized ourselves with this position, I'll show you how to adjust our lick for each of the common chords in a standard blues progression. Let's get started!

Source Scales:

Version #1: (Performed over the 1 chord- E7)

Lick #2: (Performed over the 4 chord - A7)


Version #3: (Performed over the 5 chord - B7)
