

How to Read Sheet Music 1 /4




Each staff line is a designated note. Starting on E, they are E G B D F, taught to me as "Every Good Boy Deserves Fudge" Note the time signature reads 4/4, this means 4 quarter notes. Counted as 1 - 2 - 3 - 4



So spaces between the lines are FACE, this being a little easier to remember.



Here we have the C major scale in both tab and standard notation form



Here we have a half note, the empty circle with a line, a quarter note, the black dot with a line, the 8th note, to black dots with lines tied together by a horitzontal line and the whole note, a simple empty circle with no line.



Here we have rests, from left to right we have full, half, quarter and 8th
