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Notes on Sourcing Information

Malcontent News uses a wide range of sources to create our daily Situation Report, the foundation for the Russian-Ukraine War Report Podcast. There are some notable sources that we frequently use and others that we don't. The most common sources currently, or in the past, we have used for the Theater of War section of the Situation Report include the following.

▲ Russian Ministry of Defense Morning Report: We use the RMOD Morning Report to identify combat reports, shelling locations, and territorial control change claims. We do not consider claims of Ukrainian troops killed, equipment destroyed, or military resources destroyed valid without videos and pictures that can be confirmed by date, time, weather, and geolocation, or third-party confirmation from recognized Western news outlets or trusted Ukrainian sources.

A Rybar: We consider Rybar a mercenary organization because they are staffed by former Russian Ministry of Defense public relations officers who actively provide target information to the Russian military. Their operational budget is \$20,000 a month, while they claim they receive no government funding. We use their reports and maps to identify combat reports, territorial control change claims, and troop movement reports. We do not use claims of Ukrainian troops killed, equipment destroyed, or military resources destroyed because of a documented and historical pattern of producing fabrications. They frequently engage in blatant misinformation and disinformation and consistently deny all Russian war crimes.

A War Gonzo: We consider War Gonzo a mercenary organization because their employees have recorded themselves actively engaging in direct combat, specifically in Marinka. Recently, War Gonzo admitted in their daily report to leveraging the information from the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine. They intermix combat reports with their own on a 24hour delay. We use their reports for **unique claims** about combat, territorial control change claims, and troop movement reports. Although the War Gonzo daily reports are moderately accurate, they occasionally engage in blatant disinformation and misinformation. **Readovka:** We consider Readovka to be a Kremlin-aligned propagandist organization. Their daily reports are a word-for-word repeat of the RMOD Morning Report and provide no value to our analysis. They occasionally provide credible information through videos and pictures that can be confirmed by date, time, weather, and geolocation.

Igor "Girkin" Strelkov: We consider Strelkov to be a convicted war criminal who is highly informed, specifically about the situation in the Donbas. We use his combat reports, territorial control change claims, and troop movement information. In the Donbas, we consider his reports to be highly accurate. The fidelity of information he provides in Zaporizhia, Kherson, and Kharkiv appears to come from other social media channels with a history of spreading misinformation and is of lower quality. Reports he shares outside of the Donbas provided by Russian Federation 1st Army Corps units have greater fidelity.

Andrei Morozov: Morozov is a pro-Russian milblogger and a radio communications and logistics specialist with the Russian 2nd Army Corps. We consider him a provider of high-quality information, especially within his fields of specialty. In the fall of 2022, Morozov was detained by OMON for up to three weeks due to his content and has had his online material censored by the Kremlin several times over the last 11 months.

▲ Private Military Company Wagner Group Social Media: We consider reports from PMC Wagner of Russian victories as overstating gains and reports of Russian failures, particularly among the Russian Ministry of Defense and the 1st and 2nd Army Corps of the Russian Army, as overstating problems. We do not consider claims of territorial control changes from Wagner as authentic without pictures, videos, or **unique** Russian State Media reports that include a video that can be geolocated.

Luhansk People's Republic Joint Center for Control and Coordination: We only use their reports about large-scale artillery and HIMARS strikes in the occupied territories. **Leonid Pasechnik:** We do not use any combat, territorial control changes, troop movements, casualty claims, or equipment destroyed claims from the self-declared leader of the so-called Luhansk People's Republic.

Donetsk People's Republic People's Militia: We only use their reports for videos and pictures that can be confirmed by date, time, weather, and geolocation.

Donetsk People's Republic Territorial Defense: We do not use combat, territorial control changes, troop movements, casualty claims, or equipment destroyed claims from their public relations and social media channels. They have repeatedly engaged in misinformation and disinformation.

Denis Pushilin: We do not use any combat, territorial control changes, troop movements, casualty claims, or equipment destroyed claims from the self-declared leader of the so-called Donetsk People's Republic.

Ramzan Kadyrov: The contribution and impact of Chechen forces in Ukraine have become minimal, and Akhmat no longer produces large volumes of video content that can be geolocated. We continue to monitor his channels.

General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine: We consider the morning and evening reports, specifically combat reports, territorial control changes, and troop movements, from GSAFU to be high quality. The Ukrainian General Staff uses clever wording to create plausible deniability of battlefield failures. Combat reports start with "repelled attacks of the occupant forces in the vicinities of," which negates reporting fighting in areas where territory was lost. Instead of misinformation or disinformation, GSAFU engages in omission. Reports about problems within the Russian military are given more weight if the SBU or GUR reinforces them or if there is added confirmation in the Russian milblogger information space.

DeepState: We use the Daily Report from DeepState for combat reports and territorial control changes. They frequently support their claims with geolocated, time, date, and weather-confirmed pictures and videos, making them a high-quality Ukrainian-based source. They occasionally overstate Russian territorial control claims but never present disinformation or misinformation. Combined with the reports from GSAFU, gaps in combat reports are filled. We support DeepState through their Patreon at \$10 a month.

Institute for the Study of War: We occasionally leverage the map and territorial control change information produced by the ISW when there is conflicting data. Their presentation of Russian-assessed, Ukrainian-assessed, and Russian-claimed information is helpful when our analysts have to make a judgment call due to the absence of verifiable information. We do not copy from their map but take their territorial control information as an additional data point when assessing our own changes.

Ivan Fedorov: We use information about insurgent activity and HIMARS strikes in Zaporizhia provided by Fedorov, the exiled mayor of Melitiopol.

Vitaly Kim: When there are reports of potential air raids in Ukraine, we monitor Kim, the Mykolaiv Oblast Administrative and Military Governor, for realtime reports. Kim is consistently one of the first, if not the first, Ukrainian government official to confirm kamikaze drones or missiles have been launched toward Ukraine.

Oleksiy Arestovych: We no longer use the information provided by Arestovych after being fired from his role as the Chief Advisor to the President of Ukraine. Before being terminated, Arestovych had developed a reputation for providing exaggerated, unverified, and false claims for Ukrainian successes and failures.

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SUMMARY – DAY 443

This is the first update for May 13, 2023.

It has been 3,362 days since Russia occupied the Crimea Peninsula on January 27, 2014, and one year and 79 days since Russia expanded its war against Ukraine.

DAILY ASSESSMENT


We assess the following:

- 1. Our assessment that there was a continued risk of missile and drone strikes across Ukraine continues to be accurate.
- 2. Our earlier assessment that the rupture between the Russian Ministry of Defense and Private Military Company (PMC) Wagner Group could disrupt Russian military operations in the Soledar and Bakhmut Operational Areas was accurate, with PMC Wagner's leader, Yevgeny Prigozhin and Russian Minister of Defense Sergei Shoigu, escalating their dispute.
- 3. We maintain that Ukrainian forces have ended their retrograde operation in Bakhmut and continue to opportunistically launch limited offensives on the northern and southern flanks while holding combat destroyed PMC Wagner units in place.
- 4. We maintain that Ukraine has seized the battlefield initiative in all operational areas. This is the last day of this entry.
- 5. In preparation for larger offensive operations, Ukrainian forces continue shaping operations on multiple axes, creating panic and uncertainty among

gauleiters, Russian administrators, and military leaders.

6. We have identified shaping activity by the Ukrainian Armed Forces in four locations that could indicate a larger attack is being prepared.



If you see a settlement name highlighted <u>like this</u>, it is a link to our war map that will take you to the location explained in the Situation Report.

Russia-Ukraine War Report Map




UKRAINE WEATHER



The ECMWF Euro model forecast is unchanged, with sunny and seasonable weather in eastern Ukraine through May 19. Highs will be from 17° to 27° Celcius, with lows from 6° to 14°. Winds up to 40 kph are possible overnight on Thursday. The new moon is on May 19, and the full moon is on June 4.






May 20, 2023 GFS forecast indicates soil saturation will be from 25% to 75% to 40 centimeters depth in Zaporizhia and the Donbas. The black line is the current line of conflict.


Soil saturation along the line of conflict is at 35% to 70%, with no rain in the forecast through May 19. Ground conditions are now favorable for armored vehicles and mobility along the entire line of conflict.






Free Kharkiv

- The city of Kharkiv and the settlement of Zolochiv were hit by Russian S-300 antiaircraft missiles used for a ground attack⁴
- Missiles struck the Novobavar District of Kharkiv, striking transportation infrastructure and damaging a dormitory and an apartment building
- Two missiles landed between residential buildings in Zolochiv, breaking windows and destroying outbuildings
- While the area is small, a Russian withdrawal to the Kharkiv-Luhansk administrative border would put the P-66 Highway Russian Ground Line of Communication (GLOC – supply line) and the logistic hub at Troitske into artillery range







NORTHEAST DONETSK



Russian Objective: Capture Bakhmut, set conditions to attack Kramatorsk, Slovyansk, and Siversk, and capture the entire region

Ukrainian Objective: Defend Siversk and Bakhmut, push into the Luhansk oblast, and minimize civilian casualties

Bakhmut Operational Area

 PMC Wagner leader Prigozhin released multiple videos moving from rage to calm analytics in the span of 24 hours – in one video,
 <u>Prigozhin seemed to hint that</u>
 armed rebellion could occur in Russia if troops aren't treated better, "In this stupid war, the only saint and totally innocent of all mistakes is the Russian soldier, who has been abandoned to his fate and decided that he must die the way they like from their mahogany offices. When the Russian soldier realizes what is going on around him and raises his head, I am sure he will figure out who is framing him and hang [?] their asses from the fascist sign of those guilty of the tragedy he was abandoned in."⁷

- On May 12, Prigozhin claimed Wagnerites were shooting Russian troops for abandoning their positions⁸
- Prigozhin issued a statement claiming that the Russian Ministry of Defense has broken off all channels of communication with Wagner Group, writing, "...an employee of the PMC Wagner tried to send a letter from Yevgeny Prigozhin to the Minister of Defense of the Russian Federation Sergei Shoigu through the courier postal service on Frunzenskaya Embankment (6 Central Department of the FSP). The acceptance of the letter was refused due to the personal order of Shoigu and the proceedings after the acceptance of previous letters. The letter reflected the problems with the units of the Russain Federation Ministry of Defense



on the flanks, and also attached mass appeals of mobilized people who wish to join the Wagner PMC due to the lack of control in the units of the RF Ministry of Defense. The detailed text of the letter is not published in connection with an attempt to resolve these issues in a non-public way."⁹

- Editor's Note: In a "non-public way?" The disintegration of cooperation between RMOD and Wagner has been on public display since November 2022, when we first assessed Prigozhin's actions and words would be viewed as a threat by the Kremlin.
- RMOD said Russian forces conducted 98 fire missions, and army aviation and Airforce (VKS) carried out nine close air support sorties¹⁰
- We estimate that Ukrainian forces maintain control of 2.8 square kilometers of Bakhmut (1.08 square miles), or roughly 6.7% of the city, which is 41.6 square kilometers

Northwest Bakhmut

- GSAFU reported that Russian-aligned forces attempted to regain lost positions near <u>Orikhovo-Vasylivka</u> and <u>Hryorivka</u> and were unsuccessful¹¹
- WarGonzo reported that Russian troops had withdrawn from their positions south of the <u>Berkhivske Reservoir</u> and retreated to <u>Berkhivka</u> – we made a minor adjustment to the war map east of the reservoir base on open source intelligence shared by PMC Wagner leader Prigozhin¹²

- Russian and Ukrainian sources reported continued fighting in the area of <u>Bohdanivka</u> with no change to the situation^{13 14 15}
- WarGonzo reported that fighting continued near <u>Khromove</u> with no change to the situation¹⁶
- RMOD baselessly claimed that Russian troops had captured two non-specified districts in northwest Bakhmut – the claim is false¹⁷








Klishchiivka Operational Direction

- PMC Wagner continued attempts to restore lost positions on the west bank of the Siverskyi Donets-Donbas Canal east of <u>Stupochky</u> without success²⁸
- WarGonzo reported that Ukrainian forces made additional gains in the direction of <u>Klishchiivka</u> from the <u>Predtechyne</u> direction without providing supporting information – we did not update the map

• WarGozno reported that Ukrainian forces launched a successful offensive in the direction of <u>Mayorsk</u>, capturing a critical highway junction, severing a

- There were no changes made to the map

- Kostyantynivka was state shelled by Russian forces, killing two, including a 15-year-old girl, and wounding ten³²
- The 💽 <u>attack damaged houses</u>, high-rise apartment buildings, industrial facilities, and civilian infrastructure³³
- Russian forces attacked civilian areas of Druzhkivka with Smerch rockets fired by MLRS armed with cluster munitions, wounding two

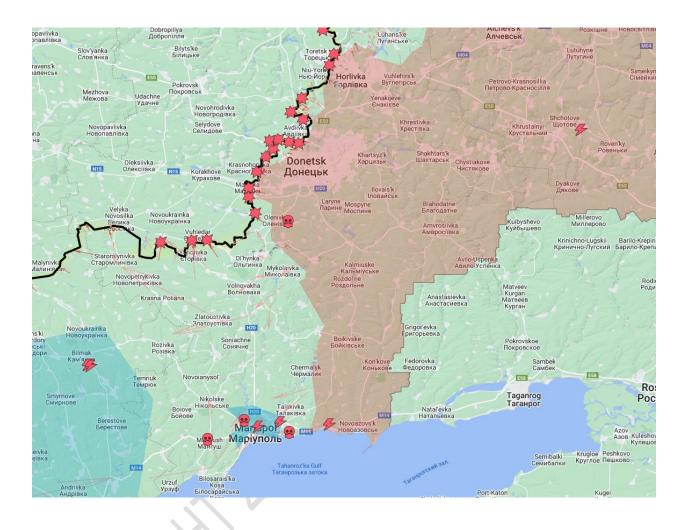


WESTERN AND CENTRAL UKRAINE

Russian Objective: Launch terror attacks on civilians and civilian infrastructure to break morale

Ukrainian Objective: Deter attacks, and protect civilian lives

Free Kherson

- Russian forces carried out 90 fire missions, firing 434 artillery rounds, mortars, Grad rockets, indirect tank fire, and drone-delivered IEDs, bombs, and rockets
- The city of Kherson was struck twice with 15 munitions, wounding six



 Russian drone video of <u>Dachy</u> showed Ukrainian forces moving through the settlement with impunity, further confirming our previous assessment that Ukrainian forces have i established a permanent bridgehead <u>north of the Konka River</u> and on the approach to Oleshky⁴⁹

Ternopil

• The city was attacked twice by cruise missiles, with the first strike hitting an area of commercial warehouses and a distribution center for a religious charity⁵⁰

- Russian milbloggers are claiming the area was a military base because a Ford pickup truck and a Kamaz truck were damaged in the attack
- The second missile strike occurred when Ukrainian musical artist TVORCHI, who was part of the Eurovision 2023 competition that held its finals on May 13 and is from Ternopil, was performing⁵¹
- After performing, the duo said, "Ternopil is the name of our hometown, which was bombed by Russia while we sang on the Eurovision stage about our steel hearts, indomitability, and will."
- The second missile struck a residential area, wounding two⁵²
- As a further indication that the attack was planned in coordination with the performance by TVORCHI, a coordinated disinformation campaign started after the first missile strike on Russian-aligned social media circulating pictures of a 2022 explosion in Iran and attributing it to Ternopil⁵³

Khmelnytskyi

- After in reviewing numerous videos, geolocation, and analyzing the historical satellite imagery of the area attacked by Shahed-136 kamikaze drones on May 12, we assessed the area was not an ammunition depot⁵⁴
- A video montage provided a timeline, showing the first drone struck around 04:27 hours local time, with additional explosions at 04:57, and 05:07 – the blasts were consistent with an a explosion of fuel, fertilizer, or other volatile chemicals⁵⁵
- The fire had burned itself out by 06:11 hours, with no visual evidence of missile or ammunition cookoff
- The sound in some videos that some have attributed to secondary explosions more closely aligns with falling debris
- The area attacked was part of the defunct 19th Missile Brigade of the Soviet Union nuclear forces, and the engines and fuel of SS-19 missiles <u>have been stored at</u> <u>the site</u> since the Budapest Memorandum was signed

• The railroad connection near the site is abandoned and in ruins, with rusty railroad cars blocking the approach

RUSSIAN FRONT

- Over Bryansk, four Russian aircraft a Mi-8, a Mi-8 MTPR, a Su-34, and a Su-35 – were shot down over a one to two-hour period, resulting in the loss of eight pilots and one electronic warfare operator
- Russian state media confirmed the loss of all the aircraft and their crews, and blamed Ukrainian forces for the interceptions despite the attacks being as far as 50 kilometers from the Ukrainian border^{56 57}
- We cannot determine if the antiaircraft missiles fired were from Russian air defenses misidentifying friendly aircraft, Ukrainian air defenses, Ukrainian special operation forces (SOF) or DRG, or Russian partisans

THEATERWIDE

 The British Ministry of Defense Defense Intelligence Directorate validated our earlier assessment that Russian forces are in a combat-ineffective state theaterwide, writing, "...the force is mostly poorly trained mobilized reservists and increasingly reliant on antiquated equipment, with many units severely under-strength. It [Russian forces – Ed.] routinely only conducts very simple, infantry-based operations. Critically, it is unlikely that [Russian Combined Grouping of Forces] has been able to generate a large, capable, mobile reserve to respond to emerging operational challenges. It is unlikely to be an organization which will effectively cohere large-scale military effect along a 1,200-kilometer front line under stress."⁶³

- Ukrainian air defenses shot down 18 Shahed-136 kamikaze drones and one Russian Lancet UAV during the evening of May 13 - 14⁶⁴
- Five Russian Tu-95 strategic bombers launched five Kh-101/55/555 cruise missiles, with three intercepted by Ukrainian air defenses⁶⁵
- At the time of publication, Ukrainian air defenses had achieved a 92% success rate
- Germany announced another military aid package to Ukraine worth 2.7 billion Euros as part of Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy's visit to Berlin – the package includes 20 Marder infantry fighting vehicles (IFV), 30 Leopard-1 tanks, 4 IRIS-T air defense systems with 12 launchers and "hundreds of missiles," 200 reconnaissance drones, 100 armored vehicles, 100 rear support vehicles, 15 additional Gepard 35 mm selfpropelled antiaircraft systems, and a "large amount" of ammunition⁶⁶
- We were skeptical that the Swiss National Council would follow up on the Parliament's lower and upper chamber votes to relax Switzerland's neutrality rules to enable the transfer of weapons to Ukraine
- The National Council has passed an amendment that will allow the transfer of certain weapons to Ukraine,

or in the future other nations, under a strict set of conditions and guidelines, representing the first change to Switzerland's neutrality since 1815^{67 68}

 After visiting with Italian Prime Minister Giorgia Meloni, Ukrainian President Zelenskyy said, "Here are good things we will do together for our defense on the ground. [We've] reached [an] agreement for weapons and air defense. As Giorgia correctly said, when we defend freedom and our lives from Russian bombs and missiles, defend them from terror in Ukraine, we push the war away from the rest of Europe."⁶⁹
