


# ABYSSAL BREWS

## FOLDABLE MAGIC ITEM CARD

**Instructions.** Print out this page on a heavy weight paper (Regular printer paper may work, but could easily bend). Cut the card out carefully but do not cut along the dotted fold line. Fold the card on the dotted fold line so that side A aligns with side B. You can use a glue stick on the back of each side to adhere the sides together.

<p><b>CONCUSSIVE CROWN</b> <span style="float: right;">ITEM 5</span></p> <p>UNCOMMON INVESTED MAGICAL</p> <p><b>Price</b> 150 gp <b>Usage</b> worn headwear; <b>Bulk</b> L</p> <p>Taken from a large beast and resized to fit for others, this imposing, dome-shaped helmet has seen its fair share of use. Covered in scratches, dents, and divots it seems that this helmet has been put through its paces in battle already. The metal that this helm was constructed from is especially durable but not so heavy as to be uncomfortable. Two large ram's horns protrude from the top making an imposing impression on those who would stand against its wearer.</p> <p>While invested in this helm, you gain a +1 Item bonus to saving throws against effects that would cause you to become stunned.</p> <p><b>Activate</b> ⇨ <b>envision</b>; <b>Frequency</b> Once an hour; <b>Effect</b> You lower your head and <b>Stride</b> up to double your speed, being able to move through the spaces of creatures that are your size or smaller, goring each creature whose space you enter. You can only attempt to gore the same creature once during each use of this ability. Gored creatures take 3d8+9 piercing damage and can attempt a DC 19 Reflex save.</p> <p><b>Critical Success.</b> The creature is unaffected. <b>Success.</b> The creature takes half damage. <b>Failure.</b> The creature takes full damage and is stunned 1. <b>Critical Failure.</b> The creature takes double damage and is stunned 2.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">AB</p>	 <p style="text-align: center;"><b>CONCUSSIVE CROWN</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">AB</p>
