Step-by-step

## **Paints** required:

## NMM steel:

- Intermediate blue (Vallejo mc)
- Abaddon black
- Silver grey (Vallejo mc)
- Incubi darkness
- Tan yellow (Vallejo mc)
- White

## NMM gold

- Orange brown (Vallejo mc)
- Mahogany brown (Vallejo mc)
- Dryad bark
- Averland sunset
- Light green (Vallejo mc)
- Abaddon black
- Ivory (Vallejo mc)
- White





Basecoat the armour with a 1:1 mix of abaddon black & intermediate blue.

We now stipple or glaze the frame of the light reflections on the armour with pure intermediate blue – add 3-4 parts of water. I have added video references for how to stipple & glaze in the post description.



We now stipple/glaze more towards the middle of the ligth reflections with a 1:1 mix of intermediate blue & tan yellow.

We now add 1 part of silver grey to the previous paint mix, and stipple/glaze the middle of the light reflections.



We now take pure silver grey & stipple/glaze the very middle of the light reflections.

We now shade the areas still covered in the basecoat with dryad a 2:1:1 mix of abbadon black, incubi darkness & intermediate blue. Add 3-4 parts of water.



We now shade the deepest recesess in the armour with abaddon black – add 2-3 parts of water.

We now edge highlight armour with a 1:1 mix of intermediate blue & silver grey.



We finally leave a couple of dots of pure white in the very middle of the light reflections. Now the steel areas are done!

Lets begin with the NMM gold areas. Basecoat these areas with a 1:1:1 mix of orange brown, mahogany brown & light green. Add 1 part of water.



We now glaze the frame of the light reflections with a 1:1:1 mix of orange brown, light green & averland sunset.

We now glaze towards the middle of the light reflections with a 1:1 mix of averland sunset & light green.



We now glaze the middle of the light reflections with a 2:1 mix of averland sunset & ivory.

Its now time to create a stronger contrast. We start with shading all the areas still covered in the basecoat with a 1:1 mix of dryad bark & mahogany brown. We furthermore shade all the deepest recesess with abaddon black – add 3-4 parts of water.



We now edge highlight the gold areas with a 2:1 mix of averland sunset & ivory. Add 1-2 parts of water. We now glaze the very middle of the light reflections once again with a 1:1:1 mix of averland sunset, ivory & white. And now the NMM steel & gold armour is done!
