


and videos that will help you go beyond the series and do some research for yourself. Whether you are writing a novel set in the 1980s, writing a term paper, pulling primary sources for a class of students, or just curious, this guide will help. The main points of focus of this series have been black and women's history, two points of view that seldom get the attention they deserve in traditional retrospectives. When reading through these sources, it may be helpful to:

- Note bias and point of view of the author, especially if they have a prolific body of work. Look up
 the author and know who they are. Even if you disagree with their main points of view and seethe
 at their literary micro-aggressions (for instance, Gil Troy grinds my gears), think about what
 perspective or facts they are offering that you did not consider before. Fact check them. Analyze
 the facts, discard the bias, and form your own opinion.
- Consider how multiple authors/publications view one event. Pull out the common and verified
 facts and then dig deeper. Also consider how different events are viewed in primary source
 documents and contemporary secondary sources versus modern essays and articles.
- Dig into the 'why' when you strongly agree or disagree with an author or viewpoint. It will help make your analysis stronger. Seek alternative sources to challenge your (dis)agreement.
- Challenge yourself to find more sources or corresponding events if something strikes your interest. Before you know it, you'll be going down your own research rabbit hole!
- Plug anything in bold into a search engine if you're unfamiliar with the term or person because it/ they are important.
- Studying the 1980s with this syllabus and my YouTube series can only be enhanced by taking good notes!

Five Tips For Your Notes

- Print out a page or two of small images of recurring people, symbols, or events. Cut and paste them into your notebook next to relevant information.
- Color code your notes! Use different colors for information you already know, information you just learned, information you need to do more research on, and questions that you have. Color code ideologies, places, and people.
- Switch up your handwriting between cursive and print. Also play around with text size and boldness.
- Write big ideas a second time on flashcards, put the main information on the back of each, and quiz yourself on your ability to hit all the points.
- Take notes on the same subject multiple times from multiple sources over a period of time (days/weeks/months) and compare.







BLACK LIFE IN REAGAN'S AMERICA

In the third episode, we explored:

- Black people's increased visibility in sports, pop culture, and politics, as well as the growth of the black middle class, or Buppies, along with their achievements.
- The ways in which the growth in the above areas did not end high poverty, racism, drug use, and crime. In particular, by examining the stories of Arthur McDuffie, The 1980 Chattanooga Riots,
 Forsyth County, the MOVE Bombing, and multiple murders by white youth in New York, we see how the storied American tradition of white supremacy continued.



- The cultural, social, regional, and ideological differences that made proposed solutions and actions on black issues so diverse. This is examined by contrasting black social and economic conservatives, radical action, looking at responses to policing, crime, and drug use, and understanding the demographic shifts of Black Americans.






GROWING UP IN THE 1980S CULTURE WARS


