On Monday September 25, 2023 at approximately ^{11:55} 1155 Hours dispatcher telephoned the Homicide unit and requested our services for a female on the roof of [REDACTED] suffering from blunt force trauma to the head. I Detective Saunders responded to the scene and assume control of this investigation.

On Monday September 25, 2023 I Detective Saunders arrived at the crime scene at [REDACTED] and met with Officer. R. Sanford (J949) who advised that he responded to the location earlier for a missing person report of a [REDACTED] Female, White [REDACTED] Officer R. Sanford later received as call for the missing female found deceased later identified as [REDACTED] on the roof. Officer R. Sanford was led to the roof by a coworker/ reporting person where he observed the deceased female identified as [REDACTED] in the supine position half clothed with apparent trauma to the head, face and Body. Baltimore Fire Department Medic 1 responded and pronounced the victim deceased 1140 hours by Paramedic Rodriguez. Officer R. Sanford notified KG to contact the Homicide unit of the death. This crime scene consisted of a brick, blood, buttons, pants, 3 teeth, broken hair clip and a pair of red shoes believed to belong to the victim located near the victim' s body. Crime lab Tech Sumerville unit 5821 responded and processed the scene for evidence. Office of the Chief medical examiner' s Officers responded and transported the victims remains for autopsy. On Tuesday September 26, 2023 Dr. Mininni of the Office of the Chief Medical examiner' s Office conducted the autopsy of [REDACTED] and ruled her death a Homicide by Strangulation and blunt force trauma.

On Monday September 25, 2023 Detectives recovered and reviewed surveillance video from [REDACTED] where the victim lived and worked which also happen to be the location of the crime scene. Detectives reviewed video from the lobby and front door cameras of the [REDACTED]. On September 25, 2023 @2332 Hours the victim can be seen entering the [REDACTED] wearing Green shoulder less top with a black and white sweater draped over her arms, red pants and red shoes. After entering the building, the victim can be seen getting off the couch in the lobby and walking to the front door to a black male. Front door camera revealed a tall bald light skin black male wearing black glasses a grey hooded sweat shirt, Black shorts walking up the steps of the [REDACTED] and look through the glass door, the male then waved to the victim inside the lobby to come to the door. The victim opens the lobby door and began to talk to the unknown Tall bald light skin black male who waved her to the door. The victim then let the Tall light skin black male on inside the building where they can be getting on the elevator together.

^{As Note} On ^{Fricky} Monday September 25, 2023 at 2308 hours the Tall bald light skin black male suspect can be seen leaving the stairwell into the lobby with his grey hooded sweat shirt in his hand scrambling for an exit. The black male located the front door and could see him whipping his right hand on his shorts before exiting the building to Franklin street headed towards Howard street.

On Tuesday September 26, 2023 with the help of Departmental databases and resources Detectives were able to possible identify the Tall light skin black male as Jason Billingsley Male, Black Dob: 7/30/1991 from his physical description. Detectives also located a witness who was able to identify Jason Billingsley from the [REDACTED] surveillance video. This witness will be identified as a later date and will be presented at court.
