SW.] MINI MONUMENT VALLEY & ANTELOPE (ANYON

SW is a series of wallpapers for iPhone and Mac that feature locations in the American Southwest. The first chapter in this series, **SW.1 mini**, includes iPhone wallpapers made from photos taken in **Monument Valley** and **Antelope Canyon**, both of which are part of the Navajo Nation.

All proceeds from the sale of SW.1 mini benefit equally the First Nations Development Institute and the Adopt-A-Native-Elder Program.

Using the Wallpapers

Wallpapers in SW's mini variants are sized for all currently-shipping iPhone hardware. Choose the files that match your iPhone.

- If you have an iPhone 5, 5s, 5c, or SE, choose the files that end with **iphoneSE.jpg**.
- If you have an iPhone 6, 6s, 7, or 8, choose the files that end with **iphone8.jpg**.
- If you have an iPhone 6 Plus, 6s Plus, 7 Plus, or 8 Plus, you have some options:
 - Most people will prefer the files that end with **iphone8plus-lock.jpg**, which are in the same orientation as the other wallpapers.
 - Square files that end with **iphone8plus-home.jpg** are also available, and are intended to support the multiple-orientation home screen on the "Plus" models. You can use both files at once by setting the former as your Lock Screen photo, and the latter as your Home Screen photo.
- If you have an iPhone X, choose the files that end with **iphoneX.jpg**.

The easiest way to get the wallpapers onto your phone is to AirDrop them to yourself, or to add them to Photos on your Mac if you use iCloud Photo Library.

Once you have them in your photo library, head to **Settings**, choose **Wallpaper**, and then tap **Choose a New Wallpaper**, and select the photo from the **All Photos** category.

The wallpapers are sized to precisely fit the screen of your iPhone. On some phones, by default, they're zoomed in a bit, so you may need to pinch them smaller and reposition them. Make sure you select **Still** rather than **Perspective**! (Note that these wallpapers are not sized for use with the Perspective effect, but **original.jpg** versions are provided as well if you'd like to position them yourself for parallax fun!)

License

SW wallpapers don't cost very much, and the proceeds from their sale go to a good cause, so please don't share! You can use the wallpapers on any device you own, or devices owned by family members, but if your friend wants your slick wallpapers, too, direct them to the website where you purchased them.
