


FACIAL CHANGES

A skunk has a very unique face shape; somewhere in the middle of a cat, badger, and bear. Of course, humans are extremely short-snouted animals, so as the transformation begins, the nose and jaw lengthen, pushing out from the face. The ears migrate upwards on the skull, but do not form into points, or grow much at all in size. Instead, their changes are subtle, including sprouting a gentle covering of fur. As this happens, the canine teeth grow in size, as do the size of the irises. Fur laces the neck, approaching the nape where it begins to merge with the hair. At this point, the facial transformation is half complete. Next, the nose widens and becomes darker, covering a larger surface area to improve the soon-to-be-skunk's food scouting abilities. White fur sprouts from the head and neck, forming a beautiful line as it comes in, and whiskers emerge from the cheeks.
