



**Leather
straps
Step-by-step**

◆ Paints required:

Leather straps

- Dryad bark
- Abaddon black
- Xv-88
- Ivory (vallejo MC)
- White





Basecoat the leather straps with a 1 : 1 mix of abaddon black & dryad bark



Now stipple all the raised areas on the leather straps with pure dryad bark – add 3-4 parts of water. Try to stipple the same raised areas on the leather straps, as the raised areas painted on the muscles too – this makes the effect stronger & more visible.



Now stipple more towards the center of the raised areas, with a 1:1 mix of dryard bark & xv88.



Now stipple the very center of the raised areas with pure xv88.



Now shade all the areas still covered in the basecoat & rips in the leather with thinned down abaddon black – add 3-4 parts of water.



We now stipple all the edges on the straps. & leave a couple of dots in the very center of the raised areas once again with pure ivory.



We now leave a single dot of pure white on all the sharpest edges on the leather straps – especially on the edges of the rips in the leather. Done!
